Evan is a Victoria based painter with a background in the architectural industry. He has been working to turn the expressive nature of abstract painting into a pragmatic and explicable one. The paintings function to visually describe their own assemblage while also exploring intersection of sculpture and painting as object or image. While the paintings borrow on a visual aesthetic of abstract expressionist and colour field traditions, the impetus is built around accessing tactile memories through material recognition. The resulting constructions emphasize physical interaction and bodily association over the aesthetic experience and are meant to connect with viewers on a tangible level. With process at the forefront, there is no longer a need for the presentation of materials to suspend disbelief or satisfy the expectation of pictorial painting for a viewer. Instead, a representation or confrontation with reality is uncovered.
